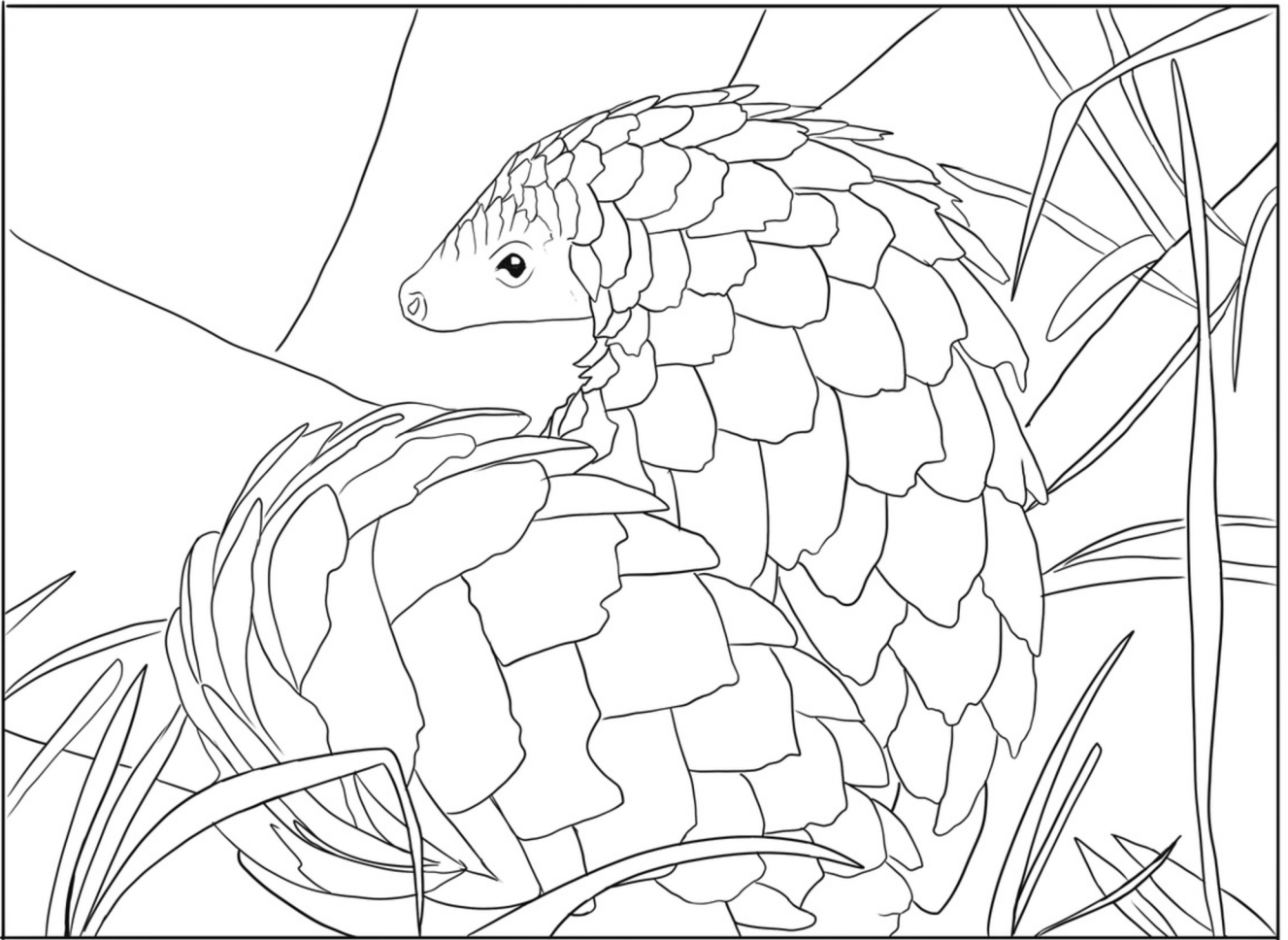




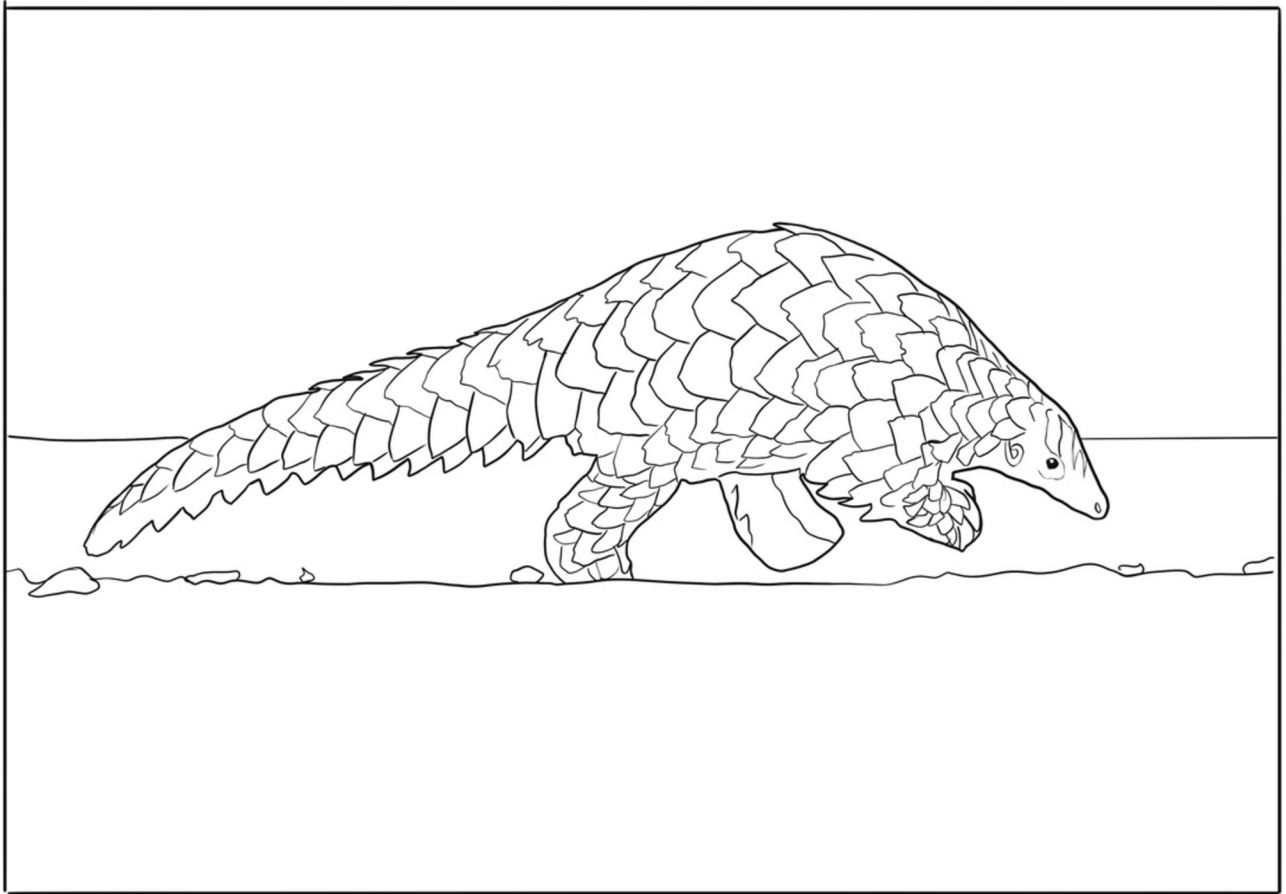
PANGOLIN: KULU'S JOURNEY

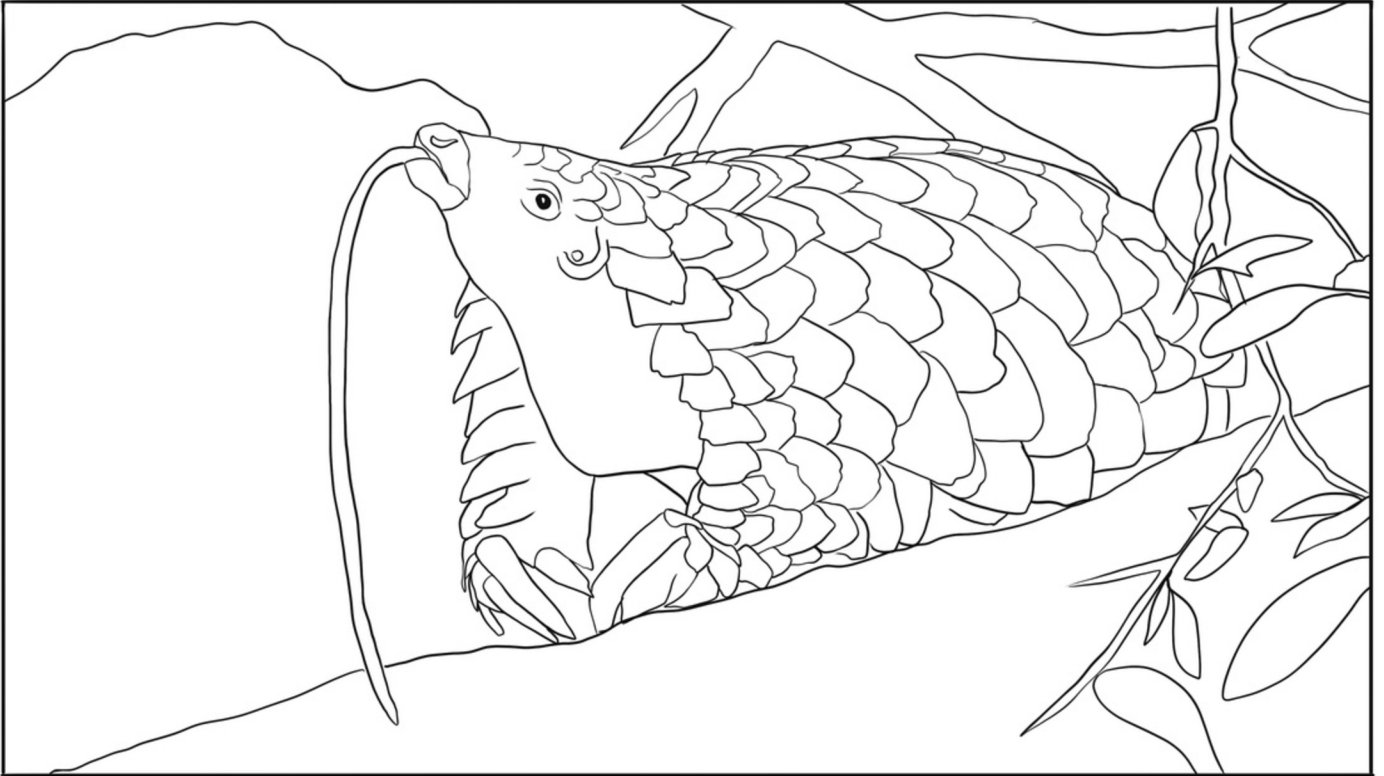

- PANGOLINS ARE THE WORLD'S MOST ILLEGALLY TRAFFICKED MAMMAL, DRIVEN BY HIGH DEMAND FOR THEIR SCALES AND MEAT.
- THEIR ARMOR-LIKE SCALES PROTECT THEM FROM NATURAL PREDATORS BUT MAKE THEM A TARGET FOR POACHERS AS THEY ARE FALSELY BELIEVED TO HAVE HEALING PROPERTIES, FUELING THEIR EXPLOITATION IN TRADITIONAL MEDICINE MARKETS.
- THE LACK OF PUBLIC AND GOVERNMENTAL AWARENESS ADDS TO THE CHALLENGE OF COMBATING THE ILLEGAL TRADE SYSTEMS AND FIGHTING FOR THEIR CONSERVATION.
- *PANGOLIN: KULU'S JOURNEY* IS A DOCUMENTARY THAT HOPES TO BOOST AWARENESS OF THESE EXCEPTIONALLY UNIQUE ANIMALS.



- THE PANGOLIN CRISIS FUND (PCF) PARTNERED WITH FILMMAKER PIPPA EHRLICH TO SUPPORT PANGOLIN CONSERVATION THROUGH HER NEW NETFLIX FILM, *PANGOLIN: KULU'S JOURNEY*.
- THE DOCUMENTARY FOLLOWS KULU, A RESCUED GROUND PANGOLIN IN SOUTH AFRICA, AND GARETH THOMAS OF THE AFRICAN PANGOLIN WORKING GROUP (APWG), AS THEY FORM A BOND WHILE PREPARING KULU FOR RELEASE BACK INTO THE WILD.
- FOUNDED IN 2019 BY THE WILDLIFE CONSERVATION NETWORK AND SAVE PANGOLINS, PCF FUNDS GLOBAL EFFORTS TO PROTECT PANGOLINS, COMBAT TRAFFICKING, AND REDUCE DEMAND FOR THEIR SCALES AND MEAT.
- AS A PCF GRANTEE, APWG PLAYS A KEY ROLE IN RESCUING AND REHABILITATING TRAFFICKED PANGOLINS—WORK HIGHLIGHTED IN THE FILM.



DID YOU KNOW...

- PANGOLIN TONGUES CAN EXTEND TO OVER 40 CM LONG, WHICH CAN BE LONGER THAN THEIR BODY LENGTH! THEY USE THEIR TONGUES TO FIND ANTS AND TERMITES.
- THEY ARE THE ONLY MAMMAL COVERED IN LARGE SCALES! WHEN APPROACHED BY A NATURAL PREDATOR, PANGOLINS ROLL INTO A TIGHT BALL AND THEIR SCALES MAKE PERFECT PROTECTION!
- PANGOLIN SCALES MAKE UP 20% OF THEIR TOTAL BODY WEIGHT!
- THEY DON'T HAVE TEETH, INSTEAD THEY RELY ON THEIR STOMACH TO GRIND FOOD FOR THEM.
